Metoclopramide (Reglan) 10mg, IV, do not repeat. Pediatric dose (<16yoa) 0.1mg/kg, IV, to a max of 10mg, do not repeat. Do not use in children <2 yoa.

Promethazine (Phenergan) 12.5-25mg, IV, do not repeat. Pediatric dose (<16yoa) 0.25mg/kg, IV, to a max of 25mg, do not repeat. Do use in children < 2
